You may already know that on January 4, 2014 the "Reduction of Lead in Drinking Water Act" goes into effect. This new national Lead Free mandate requires that every pipe, fixture, and fitting used to convey water for potable use contain less than 0.25% of lead by weight.

As of January 4, 2014, you must have made the change over to specifying or installing Lead Free* products in applications where water is used for human consumption. This is a significant effort for contractors and engineers and requires a solid plan; don't wait until the end to prepare.

At Famous, we believe that education and preparation are the keys to a smooth transition to Lead Free*. You are urged to be ahead of the game, get the facts, make a plan and make the change.

We have begun our Lead Free* transition and are actively working to move leaded product out of inventory, while bringing Lead Free* products into inventory.

IMPORTANT: As of March 1, 2013 any Famous Supply, PPHI or J.F. Good branch or warehouse location will be unable to accept any return of non-warranty leaded products.

Lead Free refers to the wetted surface of pipe, fittings and fixtures in potable water systems that have a weighted average $\leq 0.25\%$ per the Safe Drinking Water Act (Sec. 1417) amended 1-4-2011 and other equivalent state regulations.
